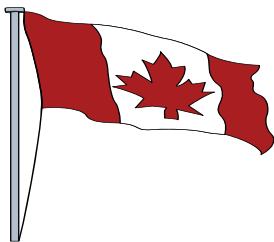

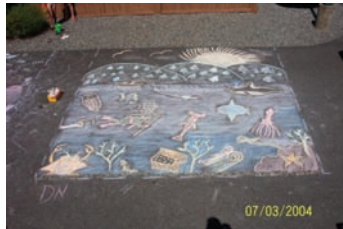
## Enjoy Summer 2004

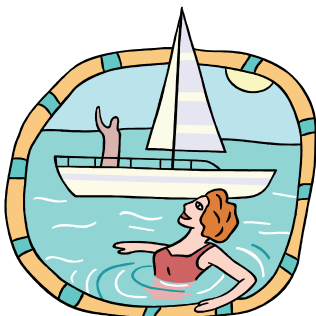

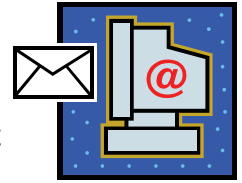

A necessary part of our park structure is the enforcement of the Rules & Regulations that were approved by the majority of Shareholders attending the August 24, 2002 Special General Meeting. Common infractions are: 1) Parking partially on the pavement. This results in the pavement edge breaking away – all wheels of vehicles must be clear of the pavement.



Unlicensed vehicles used in the park. The internal roads of the park maybe (it's unclear) deemed to be public roads under provincial legislation. **ALL** boat trailers and vehicles must have a current license in place when moved on internal park roads. Should injuries or damage occur insurance must be in place for the protection of all shareholders. The use of any device that throws, propels, or otherwise accelerates a projectile thru the atmosphere is prohibited in the Park. Examples are Sling Shots, Bow & Arrow, Pellet Gun, Air Rifle, Golf Clubs, etc.

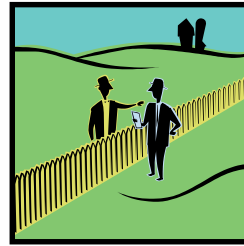

Lot 93. Please welcome these new owners and assist them with any issues in the Park.



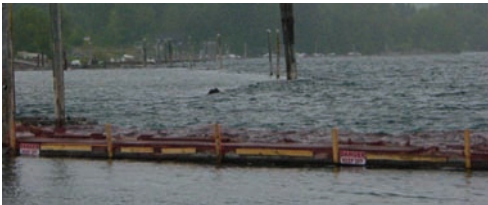
### Fence Maintenance

### Golf Tournament

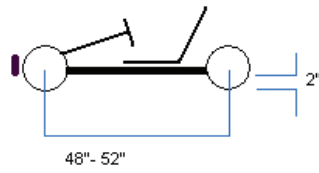
